High-Speed Rail Invests Funds in Regional Rail Connector to Improve Connectivity in Southern California

LOS ANGELES, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) is partnering with the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to improve connectivity in Southern California by helping fund the Regional Connector Transit Project in downtown Los Angeles. The Authority is providing almost \$115 million to the \$1.75 billion project that will connect Metro Rail’s Gold Line to the 7th Street/Metro Center with a nearly 2-mile underground light rail system. See how crews are constructing this underground tunnel and why the project will make it easier for Southern Californians to get around town.
