### Purpose

#### **Item for Consideration:**

Approval to issue Notice to Proceed-2 (NTP-2) for Merced to Madera (M2M) (HSR 22-02)

### Scope of Work

- NTP-2 will allow the project sections to advance to Stage 4, Early Works and Rightof-Way including,
  - » Final design (100%) and construction ready documents
  - » Construction staging plans and constructability reviews
  - » Update travel time enhancements
  - » Updated project risk assessment, construction schedule, and cost estimates
  - » Begin securing environmental permits from federal and state agencies
  - » Third-party design submittals and Caltrans project reports
  - » Environmental compliance report




### **M2M NTP-2 Limits**

- Begins at R Street in Downtown Merced and ends at northern limit of CP-1 at Ave 19 in Madera County (~34.3 miles)
- \$103.4 M
- 2 years, some work to be done concurrently with NTP-1 & NTP-3




### **M2M Progress**

- Draft Configuration Footprint approved on December 28, 2023.
- Value engineering and value analysis workshops completed.
  Final recommendations and design decisions anticipated by February 2024.
- Conducted cost estimation workshop.











### **M2M Progress**

- Conducted alignment workshops to optimize the design and enhance the travel time in July and August 2023.
- Right-of-way parcels identification completed.
- Right-of-way acquisition activities anticipated to begin in spring 2024.
- Anticipated to enter into agreements with all third-parties by spring 2024.
- Stantec is exceeding all three small business utilization goals.
  - » Small Business 39% (Goal 30%)
  - » Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) 13.5% (Goal 10%)
  - » Disadvantaged Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE) 7% (Goal 3%)

## **New Grant Funding**

- In December 2023, the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) notified the Authority it was awarded almost \$3.1 billion from the Federal-State Partnership for Intercity Rail (Fed-State) Grant Program.
- The Fed-State Grant Award scope includes the final design for the Merced to Madera segment, and the grant will cover 80 percent (about \$82.7 million) of the \$103.4 million total cost.
- A related Board Item on the January 18, 2024, Agenda includes a request for Board approval to augment the Expenditure Authorization for scope related to new federal grants, including the scope of this Merced to Madera segment.
