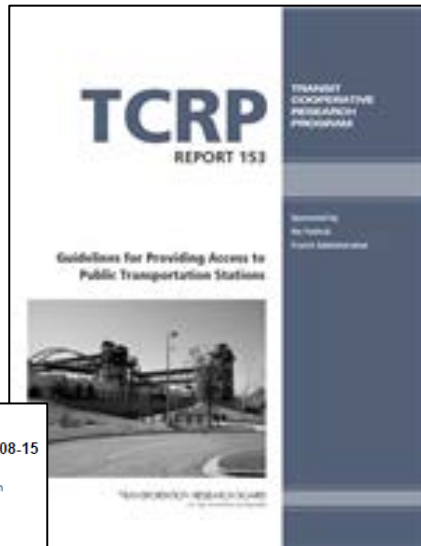
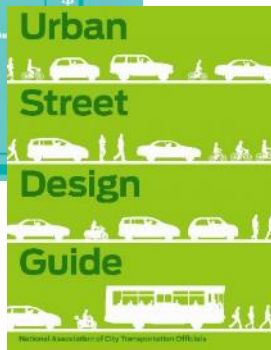
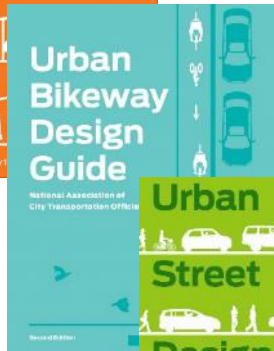
## Access policy topics


---

- ▶ Working with partners at owned v. tenant stations
- ▶ Managing curb space
- ▶ Providing and managing parking
- ▶ Connecting with airports
- ▶ Encouraging non-motorized access
- ▶ Determining when and where to invest in access (criteria)
- ▶ Obtaining funding for access
- ▶ Leveraging partnerships and investments by others
- ▶ Responding flexibly to changing access needs and modes
- ▶ Optimizing rail-to-rail transfers
- ▶ Implementing access design best practices

## Advisory Committee/Roundtable Review
