

State Investment in Southern California Rail Transit Projects

State Funding Contribution: More than \$4.6 billion

The State's investment enables the delivery of more than \$18.1 billion in regional mobility improvements. Almost \$900 million of State funding came directly from the California High-Speed Rail Authority and was instrumental in closing the funding gap on many significant regional projects, some of which are already completed.
